At the December 9th, 2021 meeting via Zoom VideoConference call, the Workers Compensation Board of Directors:

- Received a report from the Chief Executive Officer on operational items including:
 - o COVID-19 Operational Plan
 - Vaccine Policy (update)
 - o Remote Work Policy
 - o Operational Review
 - Capital Projects (update)
 - Employer Survey
- Received a Monitoring Report on the Board of Directors' governance policy on "Ends". This policy, which is
 monitored annually, provides direction on what results or outcomes are to be achieved for what people
 (employers, workers and injured workers). The monitoring report provides a summary of activities and key
 statistical indicators that are used to measure progress towards the results. Analysis indicates WCB compliance
 with this policy. (Executive POL-114).
- Received a monitoring report on the Board of Directors' governance policy on "Compensation and Benefits" which
 provided information to the Board of Directors that activities of the Chief Executive Officer with respect to payment
 of compensation and benefits to staff are in compliance with the policy. Analysis indicates WCB compliance with
 this policy. (Executive POL-97).
- Received a report on the Safety and Prevention Activities from the OHS Division.
- Approved policies:
 - o POL-19, Employer Registration
 - POL-22, Personal Coverage

• Reaffirmed their support of a recommendation to Executive Council that the *Workers Compensation Act* – General Regulations be amended to eliminate the exclusion of fishing effective January 1, 2024.
