

FISHING VESSEL INSPECTION CHECKLIST

This checklist can be used by the Captain when performing regular inspections to assist in ensuring a safe and healthy workplace.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Depending on the job task, the following PPE must be worn to ensure adequate safety:

- Personal flotation devices
- Head protection
- Eye and face protection
- Hearing protection
- Protective footwear
- Lifejackets, PFDs and all PPE are inspected and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and recommendations.

MECHANICAL SAFETY

- □ Equipment is safeguarded to prevent entanglement
- □ Hot surfaces are shielded to prevent burns
- □ All equipment is in proper working order

GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING

- Passageways and work areas are clear of clutter
- □ Loose materials are fastened and secured

SAFETY INFORMATION

The following information is readily available to the crew:

- PEI OHS Act and Regulations
- Reporting a serious incident information is posted (OHS 24 Hour Emergency Line 902-628-7513)
- Emergency phone number or contact information
- Crew safety orientation checklist has been completed for each crew member

FIRST AID SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, AND TRAINING

- First Aid Kits are of adequate size, readily available, and stocked
- □ First aid training certificates are current and available

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

The following emergency equipment is on board:

- □ Life buoy, attached with 15 m of polypropylene rope at least 10 mm in diameter
- Boat hook
- Portable fire extinguisher
