At the December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting at the Rodd's Charlottetown Hotel, the Workers Compensation Board of Directors:

- Received a report of the work from the Governance Committee.
- Received a report of submission to Treasury Board on Good Governance Compliance Reporting.
- Received a report from the Chief Executive Officers on operational items including:
  - Benefit Enhancements
  - o MicroSoft Office 365 Project
  - OHS Education Workshops/Sessions
- Received a Monitoring Report on the Board of Directors' governance policy on "Ends". This policy, which is
  monitored annually, provides direction on what results or outcomes are to be achieved for what people
  (employers, workers and injured workers). The monitoring report provides a summary of activities and key
  statistical indicators that are used to measure progress towards the results. Analysis indicates WCB compliance
  with this policy. (Executive POL-114)
- Received a monitoring report on the Board of Directors' governance policy on "Compensation and Benefits" which
  provided information to the Board of Directors that activities of the Chief Executive Officer with respect to payment
  of compensation and benefits to staff are in compliance with the policy. Analysis indicates WCB compliance with
  this policy. (Executive POL-97).
- Approved "in-principle", of the proposed substantive amendments to go to the Workers Compensation Board's website for stakeholder consultation:
  - o POL-92, Health Care Benefits
  - o POL-64, Health Care Providers
  - POL-30, Orthoses, Prostheses & Assistive Devices
- Approved "in-principle" to rescind the following policies and direct that the recommendation to rescind be posted
  to the Workers Compensation Board's website for stakeholder consultation:
  - o POL-25, Chiropractic Services
  - POL-26, Physiotherapy Services
  - POL-158, Massage Therapy

- Approved policies:
  - o POL-121, Policy Development & Maintenance
  - o POL-80, 2023 Policy Workplan
