## **Effective Safety Committees**

*Contact OHS to schedule this session for your workplace.*

An effective Safety Committee is a key factor in a good Occupational Health and Safety Program. Responsibilities of the committee, makeup of the membership, and other specific committee items will be reviewed and discussed, and a number of useful resources will be provided.

## **Workplace Inspections**

This session will introduce the components of effective workplace inspections and participants will learn how to identify potential hazards, eliminate or minimize the hazard, and be proactive in preventing incidents.

## **The Respectful Workplace**

In this session, respect will be defined and discussed as it relates to the workplace. Self-reflection and group exercises will be used to promote effective ways of ensuring that all are treated with dignity and respect.

## **Safety Culture: Beliefs, Values, Actions**

This session will discuss how shared values and beliefs within an organization will promote a positive culture. Your current safety culture will be examined, and methods for assessing your organization's safety culture will be shared. In addition, there will be a review of some current resources available to foster an improved Safety Culture.

## **Safety for Managers and Supervisors**

People with decision making authority will learn more details on the following must-know components of Workplace Safety: Internal Responsibility System, Workers' Responsibilities Due Diligence, and Hazard Identification.

## **Incident Investigation**

This session will focus on finding the root cause of an incident and preventing similar incidents from happening again. Steps to a successful investigation will be reviewed.

## **Hazard and Risk Assessment**

This session will review the components of a Hazard Identification System. The general guidelines, some sample programs and some helpful tips on setting up your own program will be shared.

## **Lifting & Back Safety**

Many back injuries can be avoided if the proper lifting and back health principles are followed. This workshop will help participants learn lifting techniques that prevent injuries and general back health and safety guidelines.
