What is the registration deadline?

The registration deadline is Thursday, April 30

Is there a group discount available?

No, there is no group discount available. Registration is priced for accessibility.

Can I register on the day of the conference?

No, you can't register on the day of the conference. Advance registration is required to provide the best conference experience for participants.

Can I transfer my conference registration?

Yes, in cases of unforeseen circumstances, transferring your registration may be allowed. Registration transfers must be approved by the conference organizers. To request a registration transfer, please email ohs@wcb.pe.ca

What is the refund policy?

Refunds may be considered for cancellations due to unforeseen circumstances. Requests for refunds must be received before the conference starts. To request a refund, please email ohs@wcb.pe.ca

Is parking available on site?

Yes, parking is available on site and there is a parking fee. The parking fee is approximately \$3 per hour or \$22 per day.

Can I arrive late or leave early?

Yes, but we encourage participants to arrive on time and stay for the day to get the most out of the learning opportunities.

What time does the conference start and end?

Registration opens at 7:45 a.m. and runs until 8:30 a.m. Opening remarks start at 8:30 a.m. The conference ends shortly after 3:30 p.m.

Can I move between sessions?

The conference has great sessions to choose from. You'll pick your sessions when you register. Attending a session that you haven't registered for is discouraged. It can negatively impact event logistics like seating and meeting room capacity.

Will presentation slides be shared after the conference?

Yes, when presentation slides are made available by the facilitators. They will be shared on our website wcb.pe.ca in the days following the conference.

Will sessions be recorded?

No, sessions won't be recorded.

How long are the sessions?

Most sessions are 60 minutes, with approximately 45 minutes of content, time for questions and transition to the next session.
